

JOJO AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS

Auditions will be done a little differently this year. Please read the audition instructions carefully if you have a child in the right age range.

Any child who is interested in auditioning for Jojo should prepare the following items for auditions (Song and Monologue.) Suggested ages: Jojo should be a mature 1st grader through a young looking 5th grader.

Monologue: *(A red and white stripe hat sits alone on an empty stage. A child (Jojo) enters and notices it.)*

Now that is a very unusual hat.

I wonder what's under a hat such as that.

It could be a thinker they call the Ga-zat,

Who balances things on his head, 'cause it's flat.

Or a stripe-loving pipester from Upper Mount Bat.

Or a sort of a kind of a hat-wearing....

(The child picks up the hat and THE CAT IN THE HAT suddenly appears.)

Cat!

This monologue and song should be prepared in place of an audition song.

Jojo

Jojo is a "Thinker", a smart child with a wild imagination. She can be played as being a little bit awkward, a little bit of a loner, or simply a rambunctious kid whose Thinks get her into constant trouble. By the end of the show, she learns what it means to be a responsible member of her world, using the power and possibilities of her own Thinks.
